Dear parents

I am writing to update you on our Christmas activities, which are a little different this year. This is because we are not currently able to get the whole school together in the hall due to fire regulations. As a result, only year 1-4 are involved in putting on our Christmas productions this year. The other year groups will be putting on productions later in the academic year.

We have to limit admission to the productions, to keep in line with the fire regulations. Therefore only parents of children in years 1-4 are invited, and they should have received a separate letter giving details. **Admission will be strictly by ticket only. Accompanying children, including those in buggies, will need a ticket if they are to be admitted.**

I am aware that these arrangements may cause some disappointment, but I hope you appreciate that we have no choice in implementing the fire regulations strictly. An additional fire door will be installed in the hall in the new year, which will mean that we will be able to get together as a whole school once more.

Next week, children in nursery and reception will have an opportunity to watch the Y1/2 nativity, and children in years 5 and 6 will watch the Y3/4 show. All children will also have their Christmas party on the last day of term, Friday 22nd December.
